JULY 15, 2018 15th Sunday In Ordinary Time

"He instructed them to take nothing on the journey but a walking stick" (Mark 6:8)

"On this Sunday, as we listen to these readings we can let them simply be another instance of hearing, 'The Word of the Lord,' and responding with our rote, 'Thanks be to God.'

On the other hand, we could take some real Sabbath time to consider the experiences they are telling us about.

Beginning with Paul's reminder that we have been chosen since 'before the foundation of the world,' we might consider what it means to be blessed in Christ. Ask yourself, 'How different would my life be if I didn't know about or believe in Christ?' Ask too, 'When have I gotten caught in the net of Christ and the vision he offers?'

Finally, following the lead of Psalm 85, invite God to speak to the hearts of your faith community and the entire church by praying, 'Lord, let us see your kindness, and grant us your salvation.' This is

the sort of prayer Jesus promised that two or three would never pray in vain. It may well be the sort of prayer that changed Amos from farmer to prophet and sent the apostles out to


