Today's readings call us to tackle
the challenging issues of fear
and trust — two concepts that
must be confronted and dealt
with by all of us who wish to live
the stewardship way of life.

The Lord knows that facing down
our fears and choosing to trust
Him with all areas of our lives is
an ongoing challenge for us. He
is generous with reassurances to
us throughout the Scriptures.

Today's Gospel passage from
Matthew is a case in point. In the span of eight verses, Jesus
addresses the topic of fear four times:

- "Fear no one."
- "Do not be afraid of those who kill the body but cannot kill the soul."
- "Rather, be afraid of the one who can destroy both soul and body."
- "So do not be afraid."

And the reassurance continues. "Are not two sparrows sold for a
small coin? Yet not one of them falls to the ground without your
Father's knowledge. Even all the hairs of your head are count-
ed." Notice that Jesus says, "your Father" in describing God's
intimate knowledge and tender care for each one of us. He is
truly "Abba," our Dad, Who knows us inside and out.

With that, let us all breathe a huge sigh of relief. All is well. Our
Father knows us through and through, sent His Son to save us,
and will always take care of us.

Let's stop wasting any more time with fear. Instead, let's put all
our energy, all our time, our talents and our treasure into trusting
this great and loving God, using all that we are and all that He
has given us to bring Him glory.
